### **Directions:**

Walpole Hall is in the grounds of St Mary's Cathedral in Palmerston Place.

10 minutes walk from the West End of Princes Street and 5 minutes from Haymarket Station.

The entrance to the hall is a brand new glass annex extension.

To enter - from the main cathedral entrance on Palmerston Place, follow the footpath round to the left and go through the stone arch gate - the entrance is via the glass doors to the left.  
From Manor Place - follow the path between the car park and the back of the West End Medical Centre – the glass doors are to your right.

An amazing venue set in beautiful, stunning grounds - that means we can laugh outside on warm summer evenings yay!!!

### **Transport Links:**

Numerous buses from all areas of the City stop on Haymarket Terrace, West Maitland Street and Atholl Place.

Trams stop at Haymarket Station and also Shandwick Place/Princes Street West End (actually on Atholl Place).
